ECC CENTURY PEDIATRIC CLINIC SET TO OPEN

Jay pediatrician Dr. Marian Stewart has joined Escambia Community Clinics, Inc. at their new ECC Century Pediatrics location at 501 Church St. in Century. Dr. Stewart has practiced pediatric medicine as part of the Jay Medical Clinic for the past 18 years. Dr. Stewart will be seeing patients beginning on Monday, January 23rd, and families can make appointments with ECC Century Pediatrics by calling 850-724-4054.

ECC Century Pediatrics offers treatment of minor illnesses, school and daycare physicals, well child appointments, immunizations, and ongoing care for chronic illnesses such as allergies, asthma and ADHD. Same day appointments may be available. Scheduled hours are 8 a.m. – 5:30 p.m. Monday through Wednesday; 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. on Thursdays; and 8 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. on Fridays. Escambia Community Clinics opened a pediatric dental clinic at the 501 Church Street location in mid-October and has provided dental hygiene, exams, and other dental care to 175 area children since launching the clinic.

“We are very excited to have the opportunity to provide both pediatric medical and dental care in one location for the children of Century and surrounding areas. Dr. Stewart has been a valued pediatrician in the communities in which she serves for many years. We know that she will be a great asset to the organization and the community, and as we work together to meet the healthcare needs of the families of our area,” Chandra Smiley, ECC Executive Director, said.

Since 1992, the mission of Escambia Community Clinics (ECC) has been to provide comprehensive primary and preventive health care to the citizens of Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties and surrounding areas, with a special focus on access to care for the under-insured, uninsured, working poor and medically needy. Designated as a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) in 2007, ECC has expanded access to health care for the most vulnerable citizens in our community, and now provides a wide range of services for both children and adults at eleven locations in Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties. During 2016, ECC provided over 100,000 patient visits to 34,500 individuals. This is ECC’s first clinic in the Century area. The nearest ECC satellite medical location is at 748 Highway 29 in Cantonment. ECC will open a new pediatric medical and dental clinic in Cantonment at 470 South Highway 29 in early 2017.
