

MOLINA HEALTHCARE OF FLORIDA RECOGNIZES PENSACOLA RESIDENT AT EIGHTH ANNUAL COMMUNITY CHAMPIONS AWARDS

TAMPA – November 6, 2017 – Molina Healthcare of Florida recently celebrated the good deeds of six community heroes at its eighth annual Community Champions Awards. The awards dinner was held at Busch Gardens. One of this year’s winners included Leroy Williams of Pensacola.

Williams founded the Pensacola Community Arts and Recreation Association (PCARA), a non-profit aiming to assist in the prevention of illegal drug use, pregnancy and violence among Pensacola youth. This community-based organization relies entirely on the support of volunteers who provide a structured learning environment for children to gain skills through fun and non-judgmental activities that include acting, singing, dancing, boxing, weight lifting and aerobics. Williams’ efforts go beyond his work with PCARA. He has also worked with numerous organizations in the Pensacola community including the Boys and Girls Club, Children’s Home Society and Escambia County Public Schools to make a positive difference in the lives of local youth.

“We proudly recognize the hard work of these extraordinary individuals,” said Maritza Borrajero, president of Molina Healthcare of Florida, “It was a pleasure honoring this year’s Molina Community Champions for their dedication to serving those in need in the community.”

The Community Champions program celebrates the vision of Dr. C. David Molina, the founder of Molina Healthcare, as well as community partners who work together to care for society's most vulnerable individuals. Each Community Champion was nominated by a community-based organization and also received a \$1,000 grant to give to a deserving nonprofit organization of his/her choice.
