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Parks and Recreation seeking citizen input through Park Needs Assessment

The City of Pensacola Parks and Recreation Department in cooperation with the University of West Florida Sport Management and Public Administration programs are evaluating the city's park system to better understand how to improve space and resource utilization.

Public input is being solicited through April 30, 2016 via a Parks Needs Assessment Survey and three public meetings. UWF Faculty will assist the Parks and Recreation Department with developing a strategic plan based upon the data collected and citizen input.
