PENSACOLA, Fla. – Pensacola State College's Performing Arts Department presents the comedy-drama, "The Commons of Pensacola," May 19-22 at the Ashmore Fine Arts Auditorium, Building 8, on the Pensacola campus, 1000 College Blvd.

Show times are 7:30 p.m. for Thursday, Friday and Saturday performances and 2:30 p.m. for the Sunday matinee.

With a script reflecting today's economic realities, this is a sharp, funny play loosely based on the family of imprisoned con artist Bernie Madoff.
