CORDOVA LANES IS HOSTING A FUNDRAISER TO HELP RAISE FUNDS TO FIGHT CHILD ABUSE

(May 26th, 2016 - Pensacola, FL) - Gulf Coast Kid's House served over 3100 child abuse victims in 2015. After hearing this at a church gathering Steve Reynolds, owner of Cordova Lanes, wanted to do something to help those children and to prevent child abuse. "Stacey Kostevicki about broke my heart when she shared how that many children from our neighborhoods were treated at their facility last year and I knew I needed to get involved." said Reynolds. Kostevicki, Executive Director for Gulf Coast Kid's House spoke at Cokesbury United Methodist Church in the spring. So Cordova Lanes is putting on a bowling fundraiser to help make a difference for those kids on June 25th at 2pm.
