Pensacola State selects new student Ambassadors

Seven new student Ambassadors have joined the Pensacola State College family.

Ambassadors also receive a full scholarship to PSC which covers tuition, books, fees and other costs.

Brown, a Milton High graduate, said she looks forward to representing the college.

“Pensacola State is such a part of this community and I am proud to be one of the voices that will be sharing the good news about the college,” Brown said. “I am honored to be an Ambassador and look forward to being a PSC student.”
