Speed Limit Reduction Planned for I-10 near U.S. 29 in Escambia County

Chipley, FL - Construction work on Interstate 10 (I-10) near the U.S. 29 interchange (Exits 10A and 10B) will temporarily reduce the speed limit to 50 mph beginning Friday, June 3.

In addition, the Florida Department of Transportation is now requiring commercial trucks traveling east on I-10 to use the right lane as they approach the U.S. 29 interchange.

Drivers are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling through work zones and to be alert for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
