Pensacola Welcomes the Running of the Bull Ole!!

14th-Century Spanish Festival Comes to Pensacola (Via Pamplona, Spain & New Orleans)

Viva Festival de San Fermin!

For the 6th year, Seville Quarter is recreating the "Running of the Bulls" in historic downtown Pensacola. The tribute to Pensacola's Spanish heritage will be staged July 21 to 23 in the area surrounding the popular entertainment complex. This year the Running of the Bulls will benefit USO of Northwest Florida. USO centers provide a warm and comforting place where service members can connect to loved ones via Internet or phone, play a video game, catch a movie, have a snack or just put their feet up and relax. Our local USO has centers at Pensacola International Airport; Ft. Walton Beach – Destin Airport and on board NAS Pensacola.

Thursday the weekend will officially begin with a Spanish Wine Dinner pairing food with wines selected by connoisseur, Bill Carlton. The cost is \$70 per person (gratuity not included) and reservations will be limited to eighty guests. Patrons are encouraged to Spanish themed garb ~ the more festive the better.

Friday night, in conjunction with the downtown's Gallery Night, the Chupinzaio (opening celebration) will feature a procession honoring San Fermin, the Patron Saint of Pamplona, Spain with members of the Krewe of Andres de Pez. A local "Padre" will make the traditional opening remarks and local dignitaries will dedicate the weekend to St. Fermin.

The main event will be Saturday's "Encierro" a safer reenactment of Pamplona's Bull Run. This annual event, made famous by author Earnest Hemingway, has participants chased by angry horned bulls. The Seville Quarter Encierro features the Pensacola Roller Gurlz as well as other ladies from roller-derby leagues as the "Bulls". At 10:00 the first canon is fired and the runners will take to the approximately two mile course. At the second canon the bulls will be released, wielding wiffle bats, to chase down the participants. As is customary in Pamplona runners are requested to wear all white with red kerchiefs or sashes.

Following the Running of the Bulls the festival will continue at Seville Quarter with Latin themed entertainment; complimentary beverages (to registered participants) and food for purchase. Prizes will be awarded to the Best Group costumes, Best Horns (roller derby bulls), Best Senior, Best Seniorita, Most outlandish costume and the Viva Pamplona Spirit award.

There is no cost for spectators for the Friday night opening ceremony or Saturday's Running of the Bulls. Runners (or walkers) may register prior to July 8 for \$20.00. This will provide them with the St. Fermin Commemorative t-shirt as well as a wristband for complimentary beer and soft drinks. Between July 9 and 22 the cost will be \$25 and on the morning of the event the cost will be \$30. The first 400 registered participants will receive a St. Fermin bandana along with the 2016 commemorative t-shirt.

Two special packages are available. For \$40 patrons will enjoy Breakfast with the Bulls plus the full run package. A VIP weekend package includes the Wine Dinner; Friday VIP

Balcony Happy House; the Saturday breakfast and the run for just \$125.. A limited number of each are available.

Are you ready for July 24, 2016? It is the annual celebration of National Tequila Day. There are many national holidays. Some are very serious, some are silly and weird and some are just pure delicious. National Tequila Day (July 24th) is the latter. It's a day where we can all come together and celebrate all that is Tequila. In honor of National Tequila Day Seville Quarter will have a Tequila Tasting back at the End O'the Alley Bar featuring some of the best Mexican Tequila made.

Tequila, for those unaware, is a distilled spirit that is made from the blue agave plant, made primarily in the area surrounding the city of Tequila. Mexico is granted international right to the word "tequila".

The Blues Society of NW Florida's Regional Blues Challenge event will bring a full day of great Blues Music to Downtown Pensacola. Music will start on Friday in the Seville Quarter Party Plaza at 6pm and in Lili Marlene's. Saturday starting at 2:00pm the Blues Band Challenge will be played in the Phineas Phogg's room of

Seville Quarter featuring National and Local Blues Bands. At the conclusion of the competition there will be an informal Blues Jam Session with all of the participants in the Lili Marlene's Room inside Seville Quarter.

Blues organizations affiliated with the Foundation stage regional competitions around the world and send the top unsigned artists from their region to compete in the IBC finals in Memphis. The winner receives a cash prize, studio time, appearances at several major Blues events around the country and the title of "Best Unsigned Blues Band". The judges also present a guitarist with the Albert King Award for the most promising guitarist.
