Six PSC Athletes Earn NJCAA Academic Awards

PENSACOLA, Fla. – Six Pensacola State College athletes have earned 2016 Academic All-American Awards from the National Junior College Athletic Association. Less than eight percent of the 57,472 NJCAA athletes across the country earned these academic honors.

The NJCAA Academic Student-Athlete Awards are based on grade point averages and hours completed.

All six athletes graduated from PSC in May and earned scholarships to continue their studies this fall.

Pinnacle Award for Academic Excellence (4.0 GPA), the highest award given, went to Cheyenne Robert, softball. She is from Edgewood, Texas and begins Lyon College in Batesville, Arkansas this fall.

Superior Academic Achievement Awards (3.8-3.99 GPA) went to four Pirates:

- Erin Dansby, softball, is from Cataula, Georgia and enters Georgia College & State University in Milledgeville, Georgia.
- Romero Greer, baseball, is from Copper Canyon, Texas and enters Georgia State University in Atlanta.
- Hunter Kiel, baseball, is from Florence, Alabama and enters Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge.
- Christina Stange, volleyball, is from Tampa, Florida and enters the University of South Florida in Tampa.

Exemplary Academic Achievement Award (3.6-3.79 GPA) went to Courtney Heinritz, softball. She is from Citra, Florida and enters the University of Toledo in Ohio.
