2016 Mayor's Cup Golf Classic

Join Mayor Ashton Hayward and the City of Pensacola for the 2016 Pensacola Mayor's Cup Golf Classic on October 7, 2016 at Osceola Municipal Golf Course. All proceeds from the event benefit The First Tee of Northwest Florida.

The annual Mayor's Cup event is a four-person scramble with a double shotgun start at 8:00 AM and 1:00 PM and is open to all players. The cost is \$85 per individual or \$300 per foursome if you register by the early bird deadline of September 23, 2016 and includes free beverages and food, a tournament shirt, gift bag, and morning & afternoon awards ceremonies.

"I'm hoping for another great turnout for Mayor's Cup this year," said Mayor Ashton Hayward. "This is a win-win event that benefits The First Tee of Northwest Florida and showcases our gorgeous golf course at Osceola. I encourage Pensacola golfers to join me and help The First Tee as they continue to impact lives of young people here in our community."

The First Tee is a not-for-profit organization whose mission is to positively impact the lives of young people through the game of golf.
